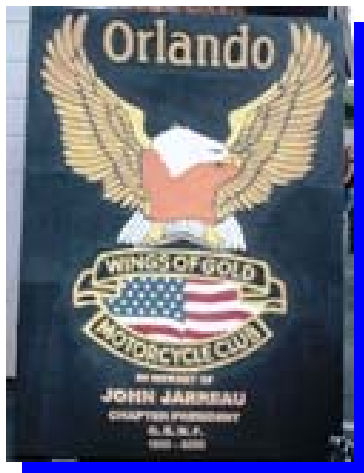
THE HEAD BASTARDS COLUMN

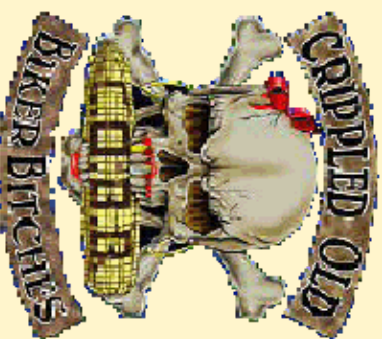
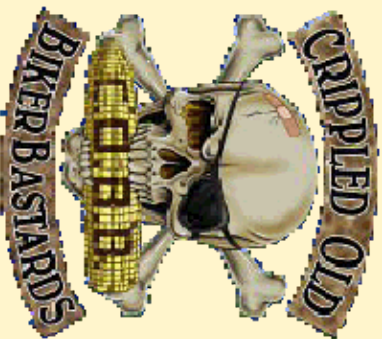
