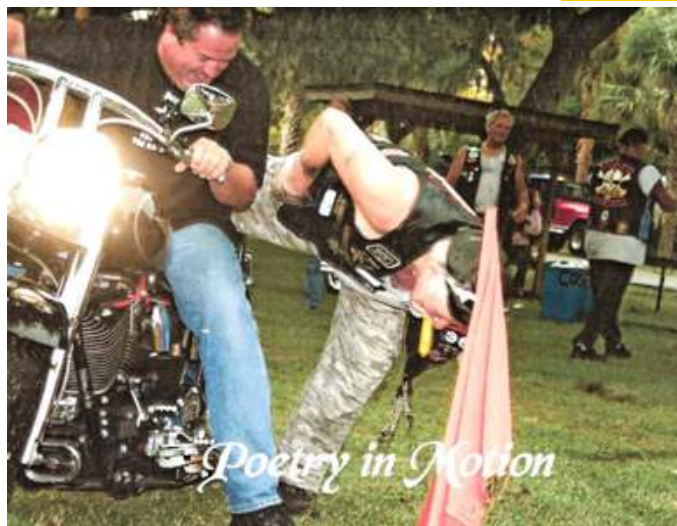
Sent in requesting anonymity for the newsletter:
